WHAT WE'RE LOOKING FOR

Actors who bring themselves to the roles, show commitment to the part, and are willing to learn new acting techniques and step outside their comfort zones. Be adventurous! If you can look and act the age of the character you are reading for, your own age doesn't matter.

THE PLAYS

For Whom the Southern Belle Tolls, by Christopher Durang, directed by Anzjuli Venter

A humorous exploration of the dynamics within a quirky, dysfunctional family. This play blends wit and satire, and actors should bring strong comedic timing to the table.

Characters:

- Amanda (age 40s to mid-50s) yearning for freedom from her neurotic son; charming, boisterous, often exasperated.
- Lawrence (age 20s) younger son; neurotic, sensitive, and guirky.
- Tom (age 25 to 30) older son; employed but has unusual habits or interests.
- Ginny (age 20 to 30) female caller; loud, somewhat oblivious, and socially obtuse.

Looking at the Alps, by Yvette Wall, directed by Maureen Coleman

As two old friends reflect on their past adventures and dream up one final, daring plan, their lifelong bond is tested in ways they never expected.

Characters (both mid to late 70s):

- Trin confident, in charge, witty, worldly, can be rather over the top.
- Sally ordinary, ailing, conservative, relies on Trin.

The Problem, by A R Gurney, directed by John Irvine

This play was written as a social commentary on WASP life in America during the late 1960s. Both 'husband' and 'wife' remain absurdly calm amidst an increasingly ridiculous situation..

Characters: Husband and Wife (ages mid-20s to early 40s)
